*Text parameters:* The text of the article is about 2000 characters (6 pages), including annotations and a list of sources. A4 sheet format, all margins 2 cm, paragraph indentation 1 cm, font of headings, main text, tables and figures Times New Roman 12 size, single line spacing, alignment of the main text to the width of the page.

*Article structure:*

Abstract; Keyword; Introduction; Methodology; Results; Conclusion.

Abstract and keywords in English (for articles in Kazakh and Russian).

List of references (do not use automatic numbering of subpages and endnotes).

Title of the paper in capital letters (bold, 12 pt, centered).

Separately spaced in lowercase letters are the authors' last names and initials, academic degree, and academic rank (12 pt, centered).

On the next line (in italics) is the name of the organization, city, and country (12 pt, centered).

Separately spaced in the abstract (no more than 5 lines).

Separately spaced in the keywords (up to 5 words and phrases).

Separately spaced in the text is the text of the article.

In the article file name, please indicate "2026 IE Conference Akhmetov" according to the template.

Articles will be published in the author's version. The author is responsible for the content of the article.

The organizing committee reserves the right to reject articles that do not meet the requirements and the results of the plagiarism check.
